

REHABILITATION OF ANACOSTIA FREEWAY BRIDGES OVER SOUTH CAPITOL STREET FACT SHEET



PROJECT BACKGROUND

Interstate 295 (I-295) is an 8-mile route connecting I-95/I-495 and Maryland 210 (Indian Head Highway) near the Potomac River to the south with Interstate 695 (I-695) and DC 295 in the Anacostia neighborhood of Washington, DC. Anacostia Freeway Bridges over South Capitol Street SE consist of a pair of one-way bridges built in 1963 and are located on northbound and southbound I-295 over South Capitol Street in southeast Washington, DC.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The project objective is to rehabilitate the northbound and southbound bridges over South Capitol Street to eliminate all deficiencies, increase safety for the traveling public and enhance the durability of the bridge structures.

KEY FEATURES

- Replacement of super structure to increase the life of the bridge
- Repair of the sub-structure to increase the life of the supporting structures
- New under-bridge lighting for improved visibility and safety
- Bioretention pond for better environmental protection
- New pavement and asphalt overlay within the project limits
- New paint for the existing bridge for increasing the life and appearance
