Weekend Lane Closures on Southbound I-295 & South Capitol Street SE/SW August 2 – August 5

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close lanes to complete work currently related to the rehabilitation of the Anacostia Freeway Bridges over South Capitol Street.

DDOT will temporarily close lanes on the following roadways beginning Friday, August 2 at 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. on Monday, August 5, 2019, weather permitting:

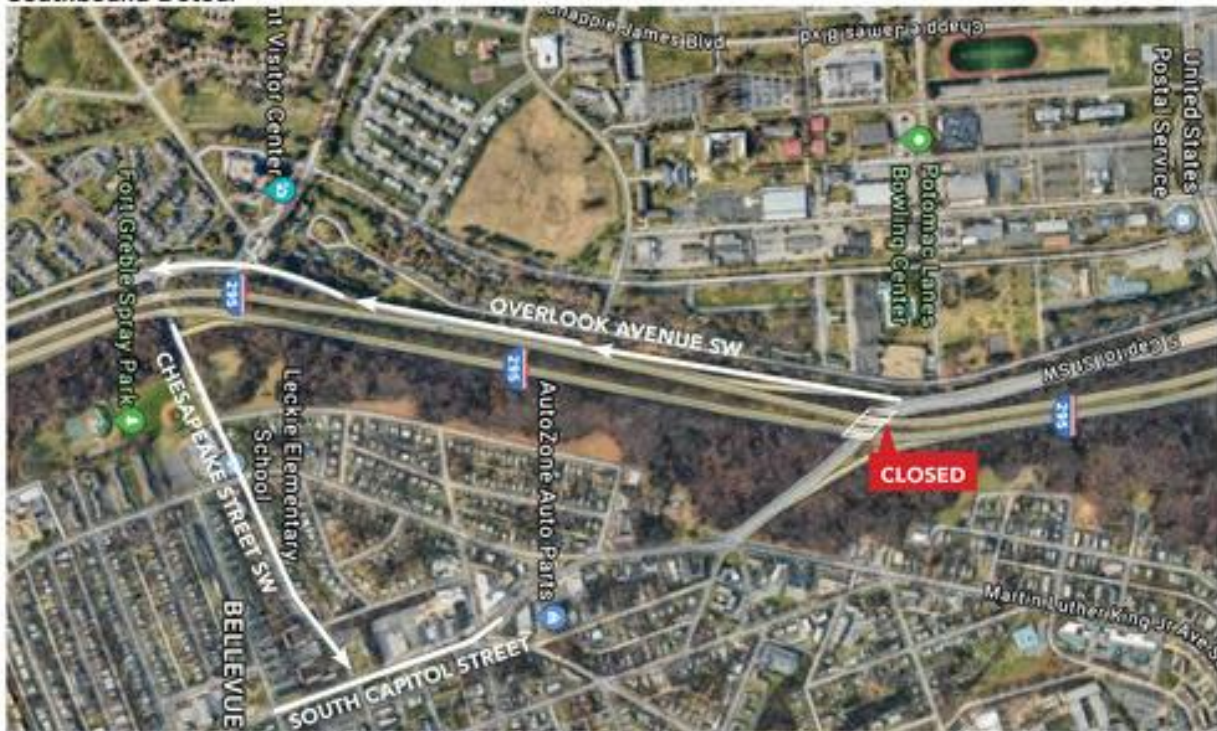
- The left lane of traffic on 295 *northbound* between Malcolm X Avenue and Chesapeake Street. I-295 southbound will be reduced to a single lane during the temporary closure.
- South Capitol Street SE/SW between Malcolm X Avenue and Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue.

During the full closure of South Capitol Street SE/SW, DDOT will provide variable message boards to alert the traveling public to these closures. Detour signs will also be prevalent along the closure route to guide motorists safely around each closure. DDOT encourages all motorists to stay alert while traveling through this busy corridor.
